本書は、2004年に刊行され、グローバル・ガバナンスに関する初の本格的論文集として好評を博した「グローバル・ガバナンス (Global Governance)」(ISBN 978-0-415-27661-0)を補完する論文集として企画されました。第1集が刊行されてから、この分野に関する研究は、本書の編集者たちの言葉によれば、「グローバル・ガバナンスの政治経済学を調査する機能主義的体制の枠組、物質的な権力・価値・規範の対立によって起こる構造的制約を超越する、第二世代のグローバル・ガバナンス研究」へと発展しています。

第2集では、第1集ではカバーできなかった分野に加えて、多中心性、ネットワーク化されたガバナンス、実験的ガバナンスなどの、革新的なテーマについても考察しています。第1巻「グローバル・ガバナンス研究を位置づける」は、「体制及び国際関係研究の古典的論文」「グローバル・ガバナンスの風見」「現代のグローバル・ガバナンス論争を位置づける」の部から、第2巻「グローバル・ガバナンスの構造と政治経済:批判的介入」は、「グローバル・ガバナンスへの規制的アプローチ」「新しいグローバル・ガバナンス・アプローチ」「グローバル・ガバナンスにおける権力を位置づける」「機関と門番」「グローバル・ガバナンスにおける価値と正当性」の部から、第3巻「グローバル・ガバナンスと国民国家:神話のナショナリズムを越えて」は、「グローバル・ガバナンスの構造」「多層的ガバナンスとしてのグローバル・ガバナンス」「グローバル・ガバナンスに国家を持ち込む」「越境的ガバナンスと事業規制」の部から、第4巻「グローバル・ガバナンスにおける変化と連続性」は、「さらなる変化」「変わらないもの」「グローバル・ガバナンスの応用」の部より構成されています。

第1集が刊行されてから発展した新しい研究を網羅する論文集として、国際政治・国際関係に関心のある研究室・研究者にお勧めいたします。
